

Hello, do you know what password is required for the below prompt? I have created via linuxconf and smbadduser the following users:


rol (my user account on redhat 7.1 Linux)

root (my root account on " ")

Babe (my machine name on my Windows Client)

I have setup my samba/smb.conf file to map to the same workgroup as named in my TCPIP identification in Windows 98.

No matter what password I enter, I get the error message at bottom



the error messages or logfile messages on my Redhat Server are as follows:
